2. IISD Updates
 - ≡ MEGS Update (Michigan Electronic Grant System)
 - Came back for modifications last week and resubmitted Friday 1/31
 - Will know soon if it was approved
 - MDE hired extra staff to review grants and provide a quicker turnaround
 - Corrie will send out email if grant is officially accepted
 - ≡ CNRA Submission-Data and Protocol
 - Worked on Process and Protocol Rubric at last meeting
 - Final version attached to minutes
 - At end of year all programs will be rated on Rubric
 - ≡ To determine how many slots allocated to each program
 - Process and Rubric sent to MDE along with how many slots requested
 - Data used includes:
 - ≡ Age eligible children
 - ≡ Free/Reduced lunch data
 - ≡ Estimated number of children within 250% FPL
 - Predicted number of slots Allocated for next year may look like this year with a slight expansion.
 - ≡ Joint Recruitment Online System

- Will replace the hand application system
- Signed a contract with CCRESA
- In process of pulling application site together

 - CCRESA made some of the changes we requested regarding including risk factor information
 - If families call 800 number interpreters will be available for non-english speaking families
 - IISD will have program preference options tab to allow parents to select 3 different program preferences.

≡ K-2 Tracking

- IISD will be implementing Illuminate ED (data analysis warehouse) and Powerschool for GSRP
 - Data warehouse for students
 - ≡ Literacy and Math Benchmark
 - ≡ MEAP Data
 - ≡ Attendance
 - ≡ All data but Parent Involvement Hub (Illuminate ED may add something for this)
 - No cost for our GSRP students
- No longer have to use paper K-2 Tracking Form-IISD will pull data at the end of each year.
- Working on how to align preschool assessments into Illuminate ED
- TS GOLD -Kindergarten entry assessment- Same as for PreK
