- Program Updates
 - Beth Whaley leaving IISD to become the Principal at Dewitt
 - Stockbridge reconfiguring- moving preschool to middle school building
 - Mason moving GSRP classroom
 - East Lansing moving GSRP classrooms
- Early Childhood Specialist Updates
 - Curriculum- Creative curriculum
 - Most classrooms have 5 book set, more comprehensive curriculum was developed recently.
 - Rep came out and gave IISD updates demonstrated other pieces that are available.
 - To enhance curriculum
 - Possibly offering trainings
 1. Jen McCaffrey to pass out sign up sheet to schedule a meeting with rep or more information
 - Valuable pieces:
 1. Mighty Minutes- Transition materials, would help with transition portion of PQA
 - a. East Lansing using and materials have been very helpful
 2. Intentional teaching ideas
 - Collaborative Breakfast 14-15
 - Currently Lansing teachers meet separately and out county meet before advisory breakfast
 - Goal is to have teachers attend to collaborate and share ideas, connect with colleagues
 - Look at 3 options (see ppt)
 - Feedback:
 1. Option 3 most popular
 2. Have received a lot of feedback from teachers that they

- would like to go to other classrooms
 - 3. Maybe have all Lansing programs (not just LSD)
 - 4. Would not be run by IISD, hosting site would facilitate
 - 5. A combination of one large breakfast and monthly breakfasts would be popular
- PD options 14-15
 - Options listed (See ppt)
 1. Sit and get
 - a. Research shows this is not the most effective form of PD for implementation
 2. GSRP Professional learning communities-
 - a. Group classrooms by proximity
 - b. IISD to set organize but classrooms facilitate
 - c. Would be set up so PLC time can be used as PD time
 3. GSRP Dinner Group
 - a. Allows for flexibility in PD offerings
 - b. Teacher lead
 - c. Creates an atmosphere for discussion
 - d. Concern about the limit of 30 people max
 - i. Could do bimonthly or invite facilitator back for additional groups
 - Feedback
 1. Comment: More PD would be valuable, and more areas of PD
 - a. Would try to organize early to offer SCECH's
 2. Comment: ECS would help to organize, offer resources, attend when possible.
 3. Comment: Does not have to be only one of the options, could be a combination
 4. Comment: PLC option would create accountability and a much larger learning environment. Similar to teachers as researchers project at LCC
 5. Comment: Combo of entire teacher pd along with smaller group offerings
 6. Comment: Could be lunch meetings, etc.
 7. Comment: Community agencies have 5 day a week sessions, evening pd is a better option for these groups
 - PD Topics:
 - a. Creative curriculum/HighScope- if this is an interest area, make a note on handout
 - b. Intro to GSRP for relief staff or new teachers
 - i. IISD planning for fall. will notify of dates

- IISD Updates
 - Family Learning Connection Website
 - IISD building this website- currently online but not ready for public www.inghamisd.org/FLC/
 - CM gave overview of site
 1. Place for parents to find information on education for their children, connection between school and family
 2. Currently just for information, watching to see how much it is used
 3. Sites will have FLC badge on each districts website home page
 4. Will have marketing materials, information delivered to sites
 - a. 3 main learning areas
 - i. Behavior, reading, math
 - ii. Gives list of questions to ask teachers, ideas of things families can do at home
 - Branding-Using GSRP Logo
 - Reminder from MDE
 1. Anything you use GSRP funds for must have GSRP logo
 - a. Newsletters, handbooks, etc
 - b. See Implementation Manual for guidelines and recommendations
 - c. For branding purposes
 2. Anything purchased with GSRP funds must stay with GSRP classrooms
 - a. If a classroom is closed, follow implementation manual guidelines
 - i. IISD collects materials back, and redistributes
 - b. What about materials that are not being used any longer?
 - i. If broken throw out
 - ii. If materials are useable:
 1. Notify IISD and materials can be redistributed
