A coordinator has been hired to engage underrepresented community stakeholders in the issue of infant mortality disparities and for developing the full potential of the Network to demonstrate meaningful change in health outcomes. Additional CAN members have been identified and recruited from the broader community to grow and meet the diverse maternal and child health needs in Ingham County. These new members will join the coalition at our May meeting.</p> <p>Regina and Kathleen identify a grant opportunity through the Michigan Health Endowment Fund (MHEF) which was established to improve the health of Michigan residents and reduce the cost of health care with special emphasis on the health and wellness of children and seniors. Responsive grants are available to qualifying non-profit organizations and public agencies that serve residents of Michigan. Grant awards range from \$25,000.00 to \$100,000.00. Grant proposals must address one of 8 areas--Infant</p>	<p>ICHD staff will prepare and submit a proposal, informing coalition members of the proposal. Proposal is due by May 16, 2016 at 5:00 pm.</p>

Three events are coming up: May 17 Advocacy at the Capitol, Site visit May 1, June 23 first NFP graduation.</p> <p>Amy Moore was not able to be present but submitted the following information to share with the coalition: Amy has provided an In-Service Training at Angel House; a Menu for Action for Black Pastors and Churches willing to celebrate Safe Sleep year round or during Safe Sleep Month has been created and an agreement with members of Alpha Kappa Alpha to distribute Menu of Actions to their House of Worship has been secured; a list of Black Churches to promote Safe Sleep Activities and Safe Sleep Month (September) has been created; Amy represented Safe Sleep at the Greater Lansing Baby Fair; Amy participated in the "DOSE" EMT Train the Trainer Program (Direct On Scene Education) which trains first responders to identify signs of infants in the home, and utilizes non-emergency home visits to provide safe sleep environment inspections when the responder is on site.
