Members: Naimah, Brittnei, Ajai, Natosha, Amy, Lyndsey, Mary. The group considered the State of MI goals for reducing the Infant Mortality Rate in identifying a topic area for the event. Goal #9--improving the mental health of women was selected. Target audience is families with focus on the importance of emotional health in the family. There will be a keynote presentation on self care by Amy Moore (based on a Seeking Safety module), families will receive a self assessment tool, a community resource fair with "vendors" representing programs that assist families with needs will be available, families will also have the opportunity to participate in fun activities that promote emotional health: baby wearing, yoga and zumba. The title of the event is "Self Love is a Family Thing". The planning group is collaborating with Headstart on the event, and the event will be held in the Headstart building(Elmhurst Learning Center). Flyers are still being developed.
