1. Welcome/Introductions

6. CQI PDSA Cycle 2 Storyboard
-Storyboard was shared. CQI Team wanted to find out how LLG information was distributed to home visiting staff. How intentional were LLG members (supervisors/designated staff) sharing LLG info? The goal was to have 4 home visitors attend the Speed Dating event that had not previously attended an LLG event. LLG information was shared with LLG members, posted on social media and LLG page on GSC website and sent out to all the contacts collected from the survey given to home visitors. With the multipoint communication and more intentional sharing of LLG information from LLG members, the test was very successful and was adopted.
