Inclusion Activity - Strengthening Families Parent Café Question

II. Family Coalition Update

- Parent Cafés The November series continues, with one Parent Café held yesterday, and the final November Parent Café scheduled for 11/27/18. New families connect to Parent Cafés through Ingham Play & Learn groups, Early Head Start home visiting services, and the Ingham GSC website. Thank you to Ingham GSC partners for promoting the Parent Cafés.
- Great Start to Quality As part of the 32p Workplan, Jessica is currently meeting with Great Start to Quality (GSQ) to connect with license-exempt childcare providers. Jessica plans to attend a GSQ orientation next week to meet license-exempt providers, and also plans to attend the license-exempt provider group the following week. The license-exempt provider group (along with their facilitator) are invited to the December 13 Family Coalition meeting. The connection to license-exempt providers aligns with the Ingham GSC Outcome 3 parent-led activity of collaborating with the Great Start to Quality Resource Center. Training materials focused on the Ingham Early Learning Calendar were previously developed for license-exempt providers and could be a resource for Jessica to use at Family Coalition. Jessica plans to update the Family Coalition brochure to include Great Start to Quality resources, along with other valuable information.
- Cristo Rey Baby Shower The Family Coalition was represented at the Cristo Rey Baby Shower held on November 2, 2018. Information was shared with families regarding the Ingham Play & Learn Groups, preschool options, and a Great Parents Great Start referral was submitted.
- Community Mental Health Zoo Days The Family Coalition participated in this event, held November 17, 2018, and distributed books and needed resources to attendees. This year's event had lower attendance than in previous years.

- Additional children's books are available to give to families during various Family Coalition events.
- There will be no Family Coalition meeting in November. The next Family Coalition meeting is scheduled for December 13, 2018, from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Please rsvp, in advance, to Jessica Baker for *childcare and dinner.

Amy Romback, publisher of Macaroni Kid East Lansing-Okemos-Haslett, and most recently Macaroni Kid Lansing, joined today's GSC meeting to share information about Macaroni Kid. Macaroni Kid is a free website and newsletter that highlights news and family-friendly events throughout the community, and publishers throughout the nation are mostly moms. East Lansing-Okemos-Haslett site has approximately 2500 local subscribers. Amy has hosted activities such as the "Cool School" contest and "Kindness Rocks" movement. Amy welcomes articles and activities to share with families. A goal is to expand resources for older elementary children and teens. Outcome groups discussed alignment with Activities and Macaroni Kid.
