 - Work to translate and provide information in multiple languages.
 - Inform and communicate to GSC members and community organizations this information is located on the Ingham GSC website.
 - 2.) Regularly update and review the content of health care, support services, and resources information on the Ingham GSC website (monthly, bi-monthly):
 - Contact OB/GYN providers about hours of operation, location, and types of insurance accepted to update the medical provider list.
 - Contact or visit Medicaid insurance website to update information about transportation provided to clients for medical appointments.
 - Add other information based upon the needs of the community.

 - Many Afghan families have arrived and have been referred to HV services.
 - Lots of language (interpretation/translation) issues in accessing Afghan languages
 - Helping families access resources like prenatal care, transportation, literacy issues with completing forms, housing issues
 - Understanding concepts of prenatal care, labor and delivery, child care, safe sleep and our Americanized version vs their experiences in their home countries
